INTRODUCTION

Today, there is a tremendous upsurge of interest in Ayurved so a need has arisen for an intensive training to produce quality Ayurvedic drug. Pharmacy education is the foundation on which the house of the entire pharmaceutical industry, technology, research and clinical pharmacy is built. The primary purpose of pharmacy education is to develop technical human resource, novel approach and vision with respect to teaching, research, development and training future health care professionals in the field of pharmacy

With this vision the Institute of Ayurvedic Pharmaceutical Sciences the first institute of its kind was started in the year 1999 under Gujarat Ayurved University at Jamnagar, Gujarat by the efforts of the then vice chancellor honourable Dr. P.N.V. Kurup.

Having obtained No objection certificate (N.O.C) from the government of Gujarat, the university is running two self-financed institutes offering the courses of diploma and degree in 'Ayurvedic Pharmacy'.



Institute:

1. Institute of Ayurvedic Pharmaceutical Sciences (IAPS), Jamnagar- offers courses Of D.Pharm. (Ayu) and B. Pharm (Ayu).

Details:

I. Diploma in Pharmacy (Ayurveda)- D.Pharm (Ayu)

Objectives & Scope: The course trains personnel for consumer sector of Ayurvedic drugs. They will be qualified to dispense Ayurvedic drugs in hospitals, dispensaries etc., training shall be imparted for maintaining stores of raw materials & finished products.

Duration of Course: Two years.

Eligibility: S.S.C.

Age: Minimum 15 years.

Medium of Instruction:	English / Hindi.
Degree Offered :	After successful completion of the course 'Diploma in Pharmacy (Ayurveda)-D.Pharm (Ayu)' Will be awarded by the University.
No. of Seats:	60 seats per year at IAPS, Jamnagar Certain numbers of seats are reserved for exclusively for reserved quota / staff / Foreign / N.R.I. students.
Admission Criteria:	Admission will be based on Academic record and interview.
Academic Year :	Along with other professional courses in the state in the month of July.
Tuition Fees:	Rs 35,000 per year (can be paid in full or in three equal Installments in July, November and March).U.S \$ 2400 per year (the structure may vary as per the exchange value during the time of admission) for foreign students.

More emphasis is given to teaching of basic Ayurvedic subjects along with modern viewpoint.

The subjects taught are:

Ayurvediya Aushadh Nirman Shastra (Ayurvedic Pharmaceutics), Ayurvediya Gunadharm Shastra (Ayurvedic Pharmacology & Pharmacognosy), Fundamentals of Ayurved & Swasthavrita, Sharir Rachana & Kriya (Anatomy & Physiology), Fundamentals of Rognidana, Pharmaceutical Jurisprudence & Drug House Management, Dispensing, Community & Hospital Pharmacy etc.

Extensive practical training is given in dispensing pharmacy at regular UG/PG OPD of the University hospital. The students will be trained in classical unit operations like Shodhana, Marana, Satvapatana, preparation of Bhasma, Sindura, Vati-gutika (pills), Sneha (medicated oils), Asavarishta, Kupipakwa, Parpati, Churna, Kwatha etc. along with management of raw drugs and finished product stores.

II. Bachelor of Pharmacy (Ayurveda)- B.Pharm (Ayu)

Objectives & Scope:	This course trains individuals to become a good manufacturing pharmacist of classical Ayurvedic formulations, a good quality control pharmacist & a pharmaceutical technologist. The candidate can also enter into the services of food and drug control administration of the state.
Duration of Course:	Four years.
Eligibility:	10 +2 with science group i.e. H.S.C. preferably with Sanskrit.
Age:	Minimum 17 years.
Medium of Instruction:	English.

Degree Offered :	After successful completion of the course 'Bachelor of Pharmacy (Ayurveda)-B.Pharm (Ayu)' will be awarded by the University.
No. of Seats:	45 seats per year. Certain numbers of seats are exclusively for reserved quota/ staff/ D.Pharm (Ayu)/ Foreign/ N.R.I. students.
Admission Criteria:	Admission will be based on Academic record and interview.
Academic Year :	Along with other professional courses in the state in the month Of July.
Tuition Fees:	Rs 35,000 per year (can be paid in full or in three equal Installments in July, November and March). U.S \$ 2400 per year (the structure may vary as per the exchange value during the time of admission) for foreign students.

The subjects taught are:

Ayurvediya Aushadh Nirman Shastra (Ayurvedic Pharmaceutics), Ayurvediya Gunadharm Shastra (Ayurvedic Pharmacology & Pharmacognosy), Fundamentals of Ayurved & Swasthavrita, Sharir Rachana & Kriya (Human Anatomy & Physiology), Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmaceutical Technology, Pharmaceutical Biology, Pharmaceutical Biochemistry & Microbiology, Pharmacology, Pharmacognosy, Quality Control, Forensic Pharmacy, Standardization & GMP of Ayurvedic Drugs etc.

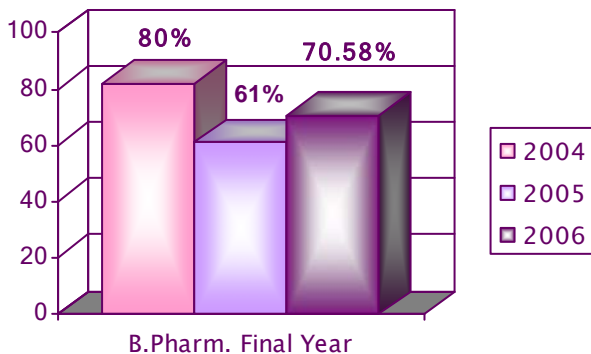
The institute presently has ten departments along with well equipped laboratories and a self sufficient library fulfilling the academic demands of the curriculum.

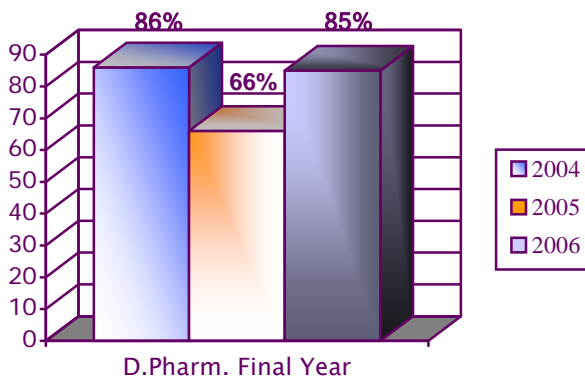

Campus Interview

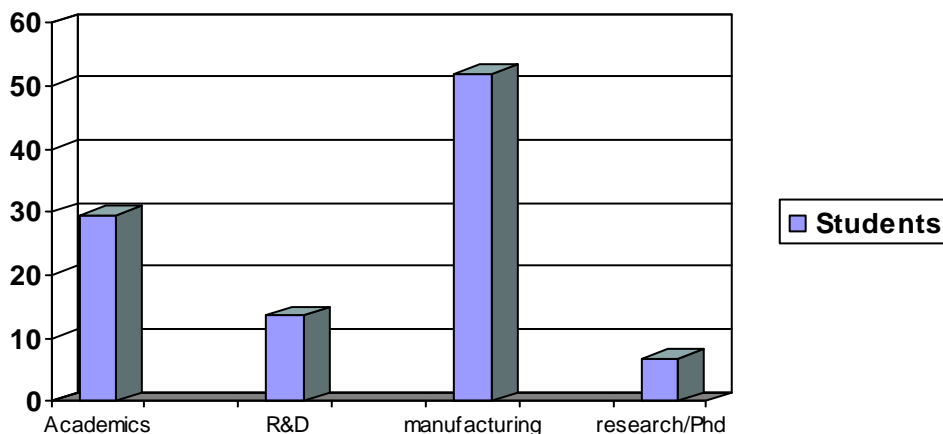
